

**Year 3 Task Variation:**

Charlie has £2.50, Sam has 65 pence less.  
How much money does Sam have?

**Worked example:**


Charlie £2.50  
Sam 65p less

Bar model

Charlie	
Sam	65p

Number sentence  
 $£2.50 - 65p = \text{Sam}$

Number line



Sam has £1.85
