

Primary Puzzle Page – Measures (Time)

(All problems are taken from 'Graded Problem Solving Cards' – Years 1-6 TTS)

Year 1:

If today is Tuesday, what day was it yesterday?

If today is Wednesday, what day will it be tomorrow?

Year 2:

I looked at the clock and it said quarter past 4.

Dad said I had to wait another quarter of an hour before I could go out to play.

What time am I allowed out to play?

Year 3:

How many weeks in 21 days?

If today is Monday 7th October, what will the date be in 3 weeks' time?

Year 4:

If each homework question takes me 7 minutes to complete, how long will it take me to do 10 questions?

At what time do I need to start my homework in order to be finished in time to watch Art Zone at 5.30pm?

Year 5:

Ravi looked at the clock and the time said 17:50. He has some time to spare before going to meet friends at 19:25.

He decides to watch a DVD. The DVD is 100 minutes long.

Does Ravi have enough time to watch it?

Year 6:

Lisa does a sponsored walk for charity.

Each lap of the field takes 25 minutes.

She has been sponsored £4.30 a lap.

She walks for 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ hours.

How much money does she raise?

For how much longer would she have to walk to raise over £30?
