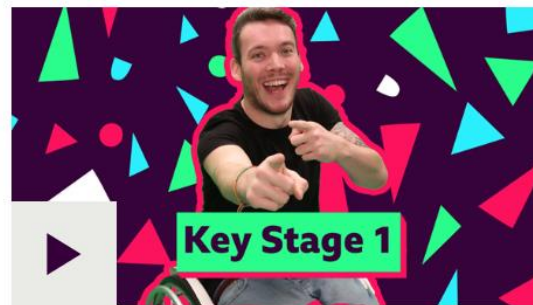

Clara the Hen will get your class up and moving whilst learning about multiplication and division. This song is a great way to introduce or recap this topic and will get pupils energised.



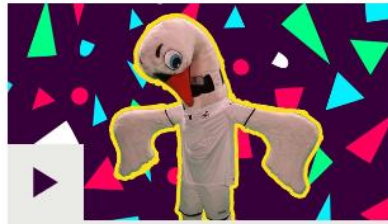
KS1 Maths: Chronological Order with Bluebell the Cow
